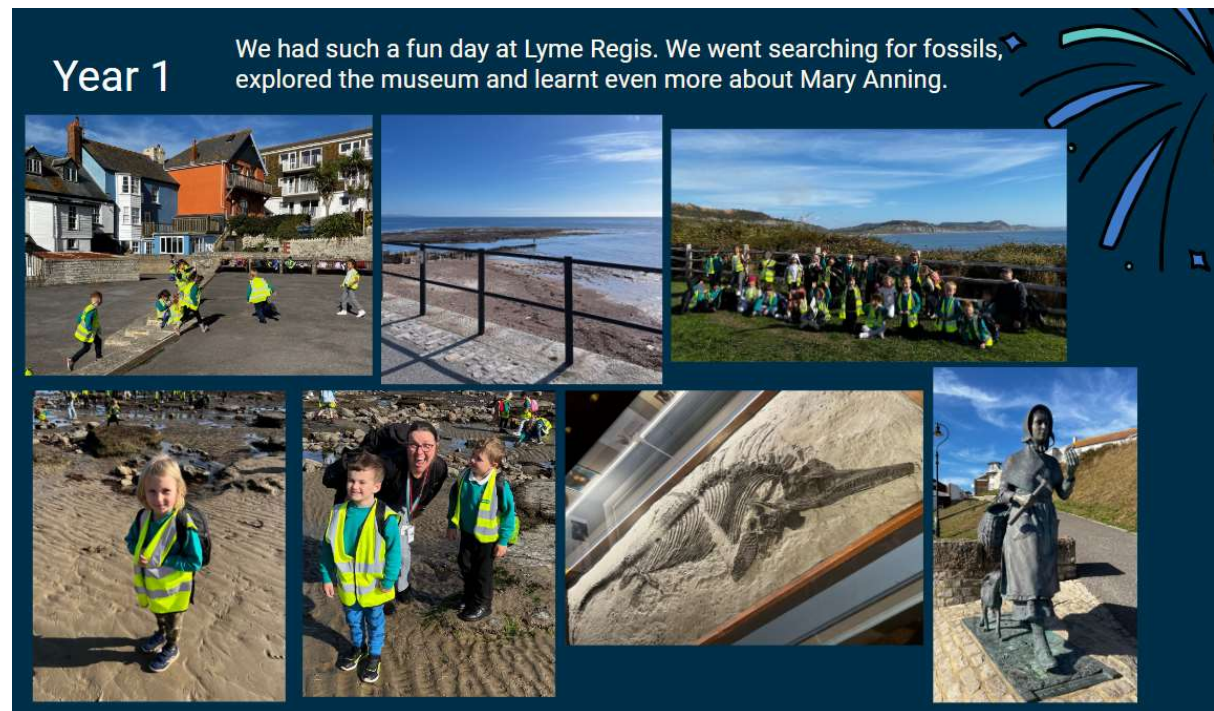

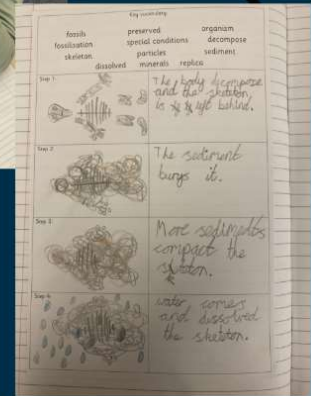

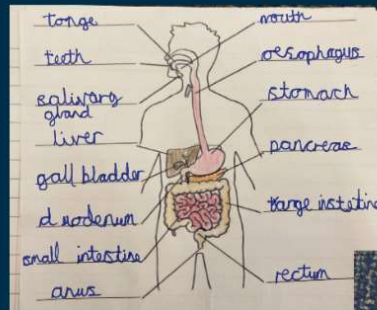
Year 3 have been learning the fossilisation process in Science. The children were also able to retrieve lots of facts they learnt about Mary Anning from Year 1.
