#### Clubs

#### Year One and Two

On Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> September, all Year One and Two parents can come to a phonics workshop run by Miss Pilkington and Miss Shawyer. This will be in the Community Room from 9 o'clock and should be about 45 minutes. Why should you come? So that you can understand how children are taught to read so that you can support their reading at home. All research shows that children who read at home, become better readers and because they are better readers, they perform well in school. We have also started with a new phonics scheme this year which may be slightly different to your previous experience. Did you know that 85% of the curriculum is accessed through reading?

# Reception

On Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September, all Reception parents are invited to a phonics workshop with Mrs Elworthy. We have changed our phonics programme this year and it will really help you to support the children reading. As they get older, children access 85% of the curriculum through reading and it is so important we get it right from the start rather than have to catch up.

## **Photographs**

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September, the photographer will be in school to take individual photographs of children. If you would like a family photograph, you need to arrive early and take a ticket. The photographer will be onsite from 8am so we will open the doors early and parents can wait in the hall until they have been photographed. After this, parents can leave through the community room and be in the playground. Sibling photos can only be done with parents present.

#### **School Lunches**

There is a change to the menu on Monday. There are no chicken burgers, so the cook will make chicken pizzas as the main meal option. The other options remain unchanged.

On Friday, when the photographer is in, breakfast club will take place in the nursery, so please drop your children there directly. Thank you.











# ATTENDANCE - SINCE WE'VE BEEN BACK!
