Covid

I would like to clarify some things about how we keep parents up to date and how close contacts are identified. If we are notified of a positive test by a parent, we will send an email to their class that day. This is so parents can be vigilant and can administer lateral flow tests if they wish to as a screening tool. There is no need for anyone to administer a PCR test unless someone has symptoms. We will not close a class and tell them to isolate and we do not take part in any track or trace process; close contacts are identified by the parent of the positive case.

Thank you to those parents who call in when their children are off ill. Please can all parents either call in, email or leave a voice message saying why your child is off ill. It is vitally important that we know if anyone has covid symptoms.
