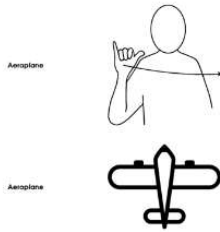

### Sign of the week

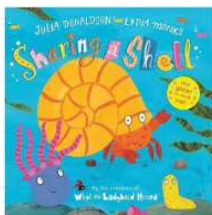

We have been reading *Sharing a Shell* this week as we are learning about the Seaside. We have also practised our bonds to 10 alot!

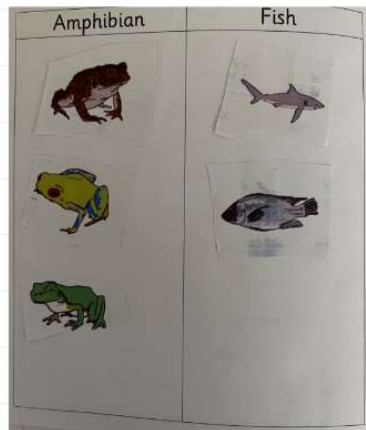
