Another busy week in school and we are already approaching the end of January.

## Meeting regarding the Road Closure

A reminder that there is a meeting in school at 2.30pm on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January regarding the road closure. I realise this is causing a lot of concern for parents and it will be useful for you to meet with the contractors and Devon County Council to ask them questions and hopefully get some useful answers. I know they will have prepared walking routes and will have maps to hand out at the meeting.

I am sorry that this has come with very little notice, but the school was only informed last Friday and until that time we had no idea that the footpath was going to shut as well as the road. Please be reassured that we have made our concerns very clear concerning the children's safety and the contractors are very aware of the difficulties that are being created for families.

#### **Gas Works**

Next week work begins on the first stage of the construction project and this involves re-routing a gas pipe from the Arena into school. This will involve some digging in the school grounds near the main pedestrian entrance at the front of the school, behind the mound. This area will be completely fenced off and secure and will not affect using the main entrance gate. This work should commence on Wednesday and take a few days.

#### **Scooters**

We have a lot of scooters being left in school in the bike sheds. Please can you check with your children whether they are leaving theirs in school, thank you.

#### **Visitors**

We have been visited this week by staff from several Wildlife Trusts across the country who were very interested in the work we do with Devon Wildlife Trust and how we integrate Outdoor Learning into our curriculum.
