



Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you so much for your support with the changes so that we get the children in to school for Early Bird maths. As I said before, it was so disruptive for the classes to have so many children coming in after 8.50 when school starts.

As with any organisational change, there are bound to be teething problems, so thank you for bearing with us, we really appreciate it. We are now opening classroom doors at 8.40 so that you still have ten minutes drop off time as previously. This has really eased things!

We have reduced the number of children arriving between 8.50 and 9 from 28 down to 15, which is great progress, thank you.

Children arriving after 9am are late and we have made amazing progress with this. We have reduced from 30 children arriving after 9 down to 4 by the end of the week.

Thank you so much for all your help with this and we are hoping that we will see the difference for those children with their maths progress!

Therefore, over the next 3 weeks I am looking for the child in each class who has logged on to and played TTRS/ Numbots the most times.

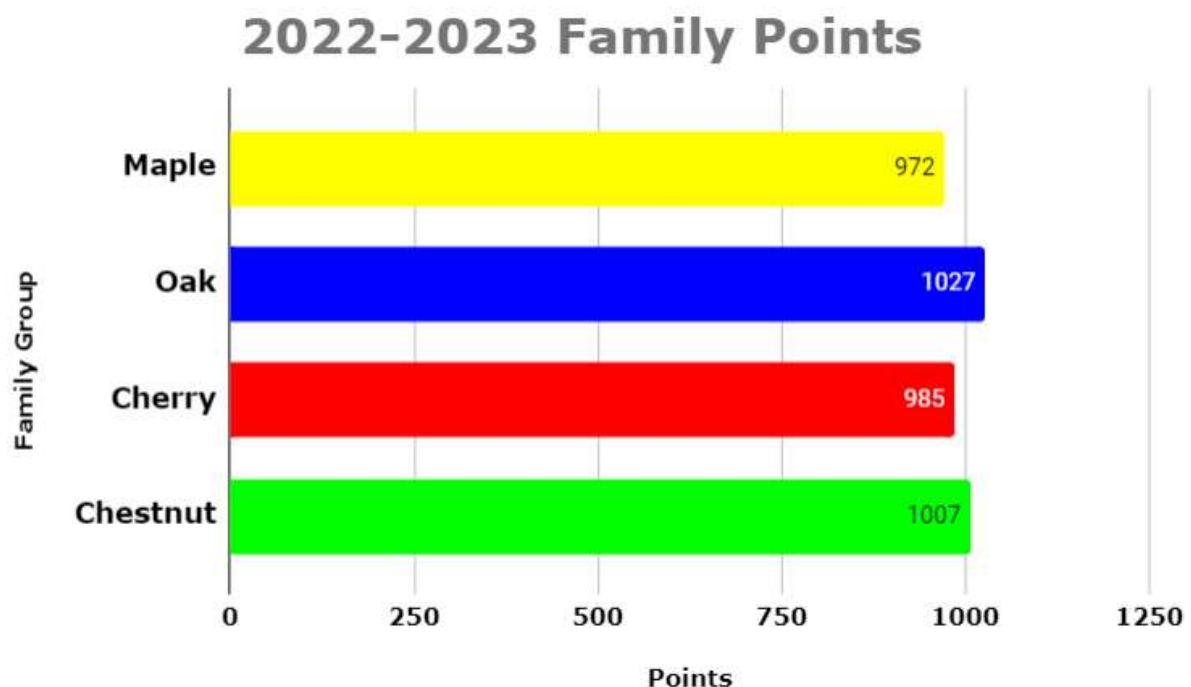
Can anyone log on and play every day for all 21 days?

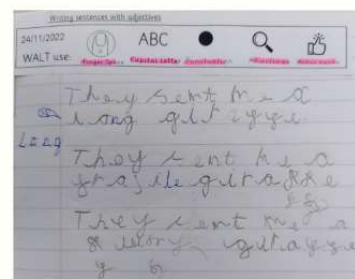
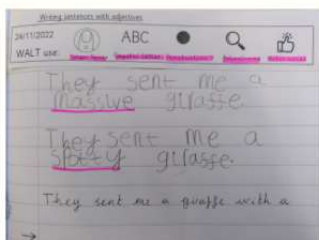
We've had a busy week but the children really enjoyed working in different family groups for our World cup day. Here we are making our own trophies and using printing to create footballs.

Year 5 enjoyed a great storytelling workshop on Wednesday, where they learnt to retell the Greek myth of Odysseus and the Cyclops!

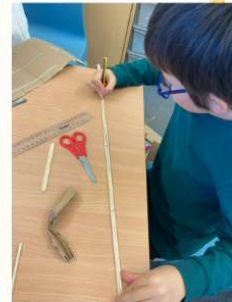


Year 6
