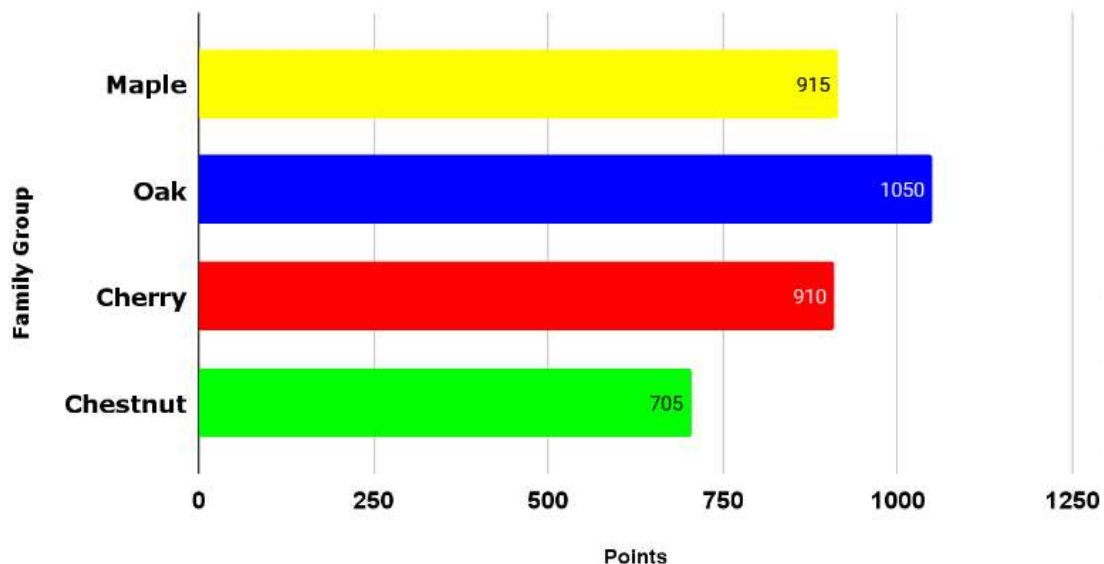

Sign of the week

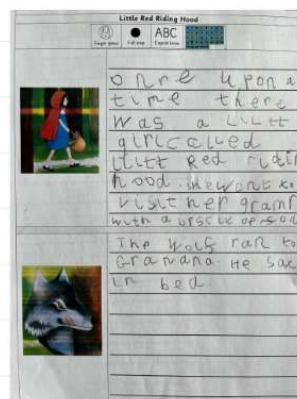
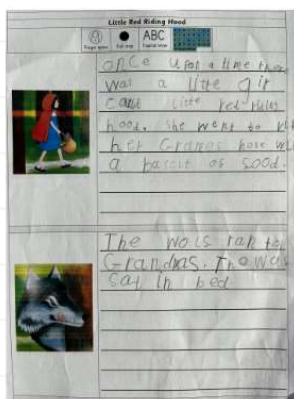

This week in Reception we have been learning about Little Red Riding Hood. We have been re-telling the story in different ways and we have also been doing some writing on the book!

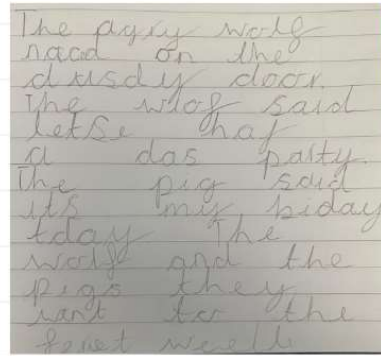
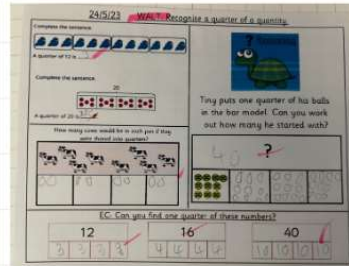

In English, we have been writing a non fiction double page about the Victorians. We are so proud of how well they used their History knowledge!

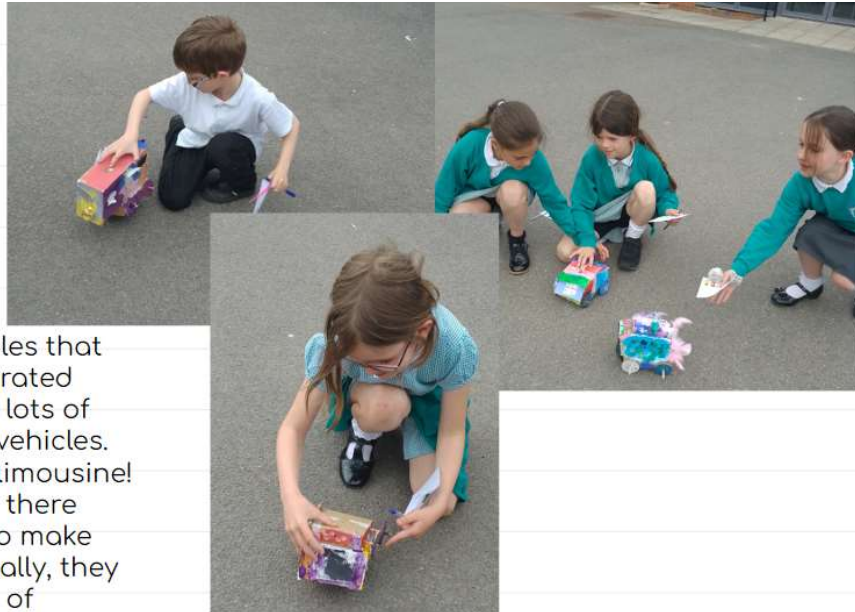
