

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This week in Reception we have been learning about Little Red Riding Hood. We have been re-telling the story in different ways and we have also been doing some writing on the book!




This week in English, we have been writing about The Three Little Pigs. Yesterday we wrote our own ending to the story, it involved a dance party and pizza!!
