Tapestry for Nursery/Reception

Tapestry is the online learning platform that we use in Reception and Nursery, to keep parents up to date on important information, as well as documenting your child's learning journey through the Foundation Stage. The children also love that parents can share pictures and information about home, which they can then share with their friends. Please can parents regularly check Tapestry as this is our main form of communication. If you do not have Tapestry set up and your child is in Reception or Nursery, then please let the class teacher know; we will be happy to support you.

COMING SOON - ROCK AND POP MUSIC LESSONS!

Exciting news! We are welcoming Rocksteady Music School to Willowbrook. Lessons will take place every week during school time but the cost of lessons will need to be paid by parents (more information to follow!)

At the end of each term each band will perform a concert for the school and their families, so you can see how far they have come!

To introduce the children to Rocksteady, workshops will be held in school on Thursday 11th January, giving them a chance to try out the instruments and learn all about being a musician in a band.
