Help with Meals over Christmas

Parents and carers of children currently receiving free school meals will be sent a letter or email with information about how to access their vouchers during the week commencing Monday 7 December 2020. Please look out for it and get in touch with our free school meals team if you were expecting to receive one but didn't. You can email them at freeschoolmeals@devon.gov.uk or call our education helpline on 0345 155 1019.

If your child does not currently receive free school meals but you think they qualify due to a change in your family circumstances, please apply online through the <u>Devon Citizen's Portal</u> as soon as possible, and by Friday 18 December at the latest in order to receive the holiday vouchers for this Christmas period.

This is the quickest and easiest way for your eligibility to be assessed and you will get an instant decision. Alternatively, please call our education helpline on <u>0345 155 1019</u>.

Before and After-School Clubs

A reminder that these are now back up and running. If you would like a place there is a form to complete to register and then after that you simply book on the gateway. Breakfast club opens at 7.45 and the children have breakfast and play games until school starts. After school club now runs from the end of the school day until 6pm. The children have a chance to do any homework, they all read with an adult and then there is a program of activities across the week both indoors and outdoors. It is staffed by staff from school so the children are familiar with them.
