A gentle reminder to all families that we are a **nut-free school**. For some of our children, even small traces of nuts can pose a serious risk, so we ask everyone to check snacks and packed lunches carefully.

Punctuality and Attendance Reminder

At the end of last term and the start of this one, we have seen an increase in children arriving through the office after the school gates have closed. Please ensure your child is in school and ready to start the day promptly between 8:40 and 8:50, when the gates close. Consistent punctuality helps children settle calmly and start learning straight away. Please note that any arrivals after 9:15am will be marked as late after the register closes, which counts as an unauthorised absence in line with our attendance policy.

If your Child has a medical appointment during the school day, please ensure medical evidence is provided via email to the school office. Without evidence, these absences will be recorded as unauthorised, following our attendance policy.
