#### **Allergies**

A gentle reminder to all families that we are a **nut-free school**. For some of our children, even small traces of nuts can pose a serious risk, so we ask everyone to check snacks and packed lunches carefully.

#### **Punctuality and Attendance Reminder**

At the end of last term and the start of this one, we have seen an increase in children arriving through the office after the school gates have closed. Please ensure your child is in school and ready to start the day promptly between 8:40 and 8:50, when the gates close. Consistent punctuality helps children settle calmly and start learning straight away.

**Please note that any arrivals after 9:15am will be marked as late after the register closes, which counts as an unauthorised absence in line with our attendance policy.**

If your Child has a medical appointment during the school day, please ensure medical evidence is provided via email to the school office. Without evidence, these absences will be recorded as unauthorised, following our attendance policy.

### Polite notice - unstable wall

You will all already know/ will have seen the wall that is unstable outside of the front of the school. We have had reports of children climbing on the wall on the pavement side. The footpath is closed there for a reason, because the wall is very dangerous. Climbing on this will likely result in your child getting hurt. We are working with insurers as quickly as possible to get this rectified, but in the meantime, please do not allow your children to go near this wall.
